Include admission requirements</p>	<p><b>TEACHER EDUCATION ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS</b></p> <p>Students should apply for Conditional Status to the Teacher Education Program upon completion of EDU 230. Standards for admission to the program are included in the section below. <i>(Note: The Professional Education Committee makes recommendation and votes for admission for both Conditional and Professional Status.)</i></p> <p>Students will be asked specific questions on the Teacher Education application required by the State of Michigan regarding felonies or misdemeanors as well as prior revocation of a teaching certificate at three</p>
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points: time of application to the teacher education program, prior to the directed teaching semester and before recommendation for certification. If there is a positive response to a question, the university has the option of recommending or not recommending a student for certification based on the information given. In such cases, the decision of the State Board of Education is final.

Students must maintain the minimum academic G.P.A equivalents: overall 2.7; major 2.7; and minor 2.3 and social standards required for admission during enrollment in the Teacher Education Program to be considered in good standing. *(Refer to the Teacher Education Program Probation Protocol in the Teacher Education Handbook or the Teacher Education section of the Undergraduate Academic Catalog regarding procedures for failure to maintain these standards.)* A minimum grade of "C-" is required in all courses with an EDU number, all Methods courses, COM-112, ENG 212, KIN-147, MAT-312, MUS-254, PSY-232, and SCI-201. Assistance may be provided to students by their academic adviser, the Teacher Education faculty, the Learning Center and Career Services.

If circumstances warrant discontinuing a student from pursuing a Teacher Education degree and prior to their application into the program, this decision may be communicated to the student during either the Conditional or Professional Status phases or prior to or during the student teacher practicum.

Students interested in the education program are required to attend two audit meetings per year in order to be aware of all the admission and program requirements.

**Professional Readiness Exam (PRE):**
