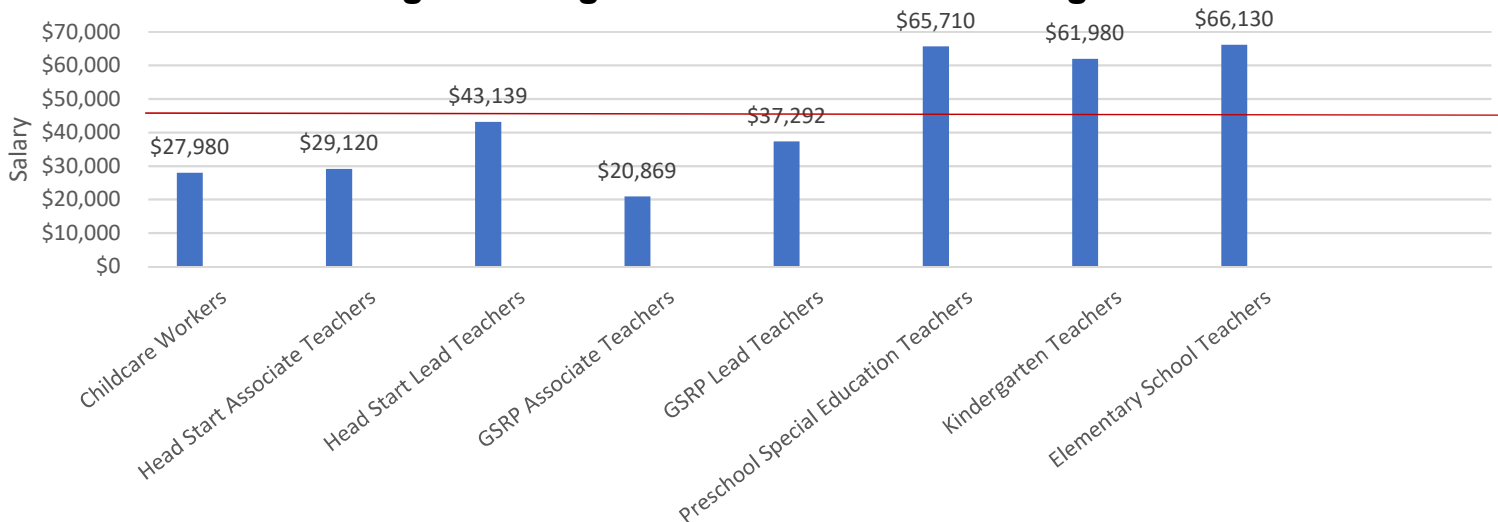

Michigan Demographics

665,886 children under age 6

32% children whose parents lack secure employment

34% children in single-parent families

18% living in poverty

72% fourth-graders not proficient in reading
